

YOUR MUNICIPALITY'S COMMUNITY CAT ANIMAL CONTROL PARTNERSHIP WITH THE ANIMAL RESCUE LEAGUE OF BERKS COUNTY

Dear Resident,

We're pleased to announce that we've partnered with the Animal Rescue League of Berks County to help our residents with stray and feral ("community") cats. This partnership reflects our commitment to help residents reduce the number of stray or community cats over time through a number of initiatives, including:

SHELTERING SERVICES FOR STRAY FRIENDLY CATS

If you find a friendly stray cat, you may now surrender that cat for no fee at the Animal Rescue League in Berks County. Appointments are strongly encouraged; please call 610-373-8830 to speak with someone in their Admissions department.

TRAP-NEUTER-RETURN (TNR) SERVICES FOR OUTDOOR COMMUNITY CATS

If you find an outdoor cat or are caring for a colony of cats, the ARL offers comprehensive TNR services to help ensure 1 cat doesn't turn into 100. Through the ARL, you can now bring the trapped cat to the ARL to be spayed/neutered, microchipped and vaccinated at **NO COST TO YOU**. Additionally, the ARL offers trap rental services for a nominal fee, as well as instructional support on how to trap and care for the cats following surgery. To rent a trap, schedule a surgery or learn more, please call the ARL at 610-373-8830. (Surgeries must be scheduled in advance; all cats will have their ear tipped to identify them as a community cat.)

ACCESS TO SPAY/NEUTER SERVICES FOR OWNED CATS

You will receive priority access to the ARL's affordable spay/neuter services for your own pet cats by calling the shelter at 610-373-8830. Your cat can also receive affordably-priced vaccines during surgery; please ask for these at the time you schedule your appointment.

MICROCHIP/VACCINE CLINICS FOR OWNED CATS

Please look for these periodically at the ARL. Microchipping can also be done by appointment at the shelter anytime; please call 610-373-8830 to schedule.
